#### COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND OTHER SUBSIDIARY ORGANS OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE

<sup>3</sup> By decision 162 EX/Decision 3.7.2 the Executive Board amended Article 2, paragraphs 1 and 4, of the Statutes of the Intergovernmental Council for the Information for All Programme, increasing from twenty-four (24) to twenty-six (26) the total number of seats in this Council and recommending to the General Conference that they distribute them as recommended by its Interim Committee, adding one seat for Group II and one seat for Group IV.

The amended paragraph 4 of Article 2 of the Statutes states that the term of office of the thirteen (13) members designated at the first election shall cease at the end of the first ordinary session of the General Conference following that at which they were elected. These members shall be chosen by lot by the President of the General Conference after the first election. Each retiring member shall be replaced by a member belonging to the same regional group.
