#### COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND OTHER SUBSIDIARY ORGANS OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE

<sup>1</sup> At its 31st session, the General Conference adopted 31 C/Resolution 65, by which it amended Rules 39 and 40 of its Rules of Procedure which define the membership and functions of the Headquarters Committee. The resolution also introduced a transitional provision into the Rules of Procedure (Rule 39*bis*) which states that one half of the States Members elected at the 31st session of the General Conference, appointed by drawing lots, shall have, exceptionally, a term of two years, until the end of the 32nd session of the General Conference.

<sup>3</sup> Pursuant to Article 2, paragraph 4, of the Statutes (as amended by 162 EX/Decision 3.7.2), the term of office of the following thirteen (13) States Members chosen by lot at the 31st session of the General Conference shall cease at the end of the 32nd session: Bahrain, Brazil, Cameroon, Canada, Colombia, France, India, Madagascar, New Zealand, Peru, Philippines, United Republic of Tanzania and Sweden. Consequently, the General Conference is invited at its 32nd session to elect 13 Member States to the Council in accordance with the following distribution of seats, their term of office ceasing at the end of the 34th session of the General Conference: Group I: 3; Group II: none; Group III: 3; Group IV: 3; Group V(a): 3, and Group V(b): 1.

<sup>4</sup> The General Conference is invited to elect the three members who are to replace for a period of four years the outgoing Member State experts and therefore belong to the same regional groups. The General Conference is also invited to elect a fourth member, following the death of the representative of Group V(b), elected at the 31st session of the General Conference, whose term of office will end on 31 December 2005. Under Article IV.2 of the UIS Statutes, outgoing members shall not be re-elected for a second consecutive term of office.
