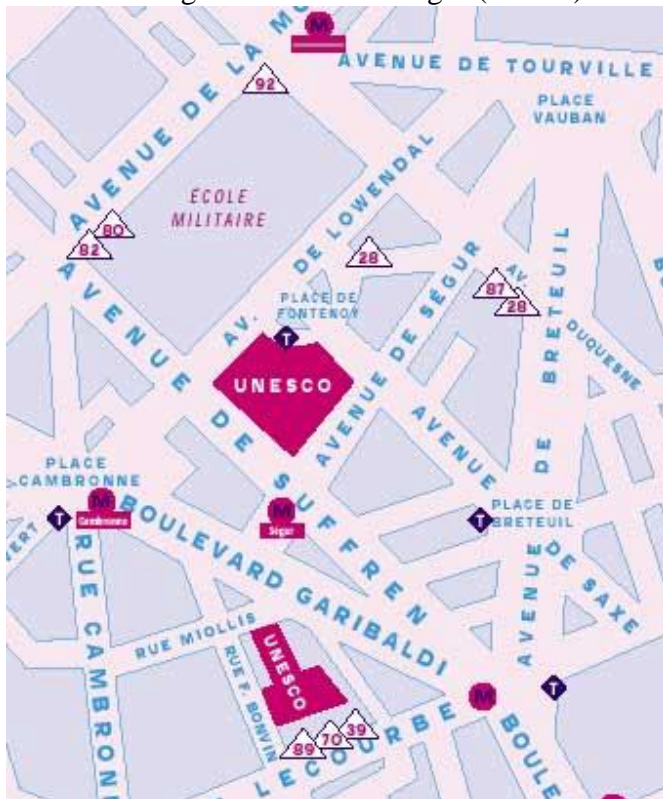

3. Entry Requirements

All participants arriving in France should hold a valid passport or a tourist visa, apart from participants who have special agreement documents. To obtain a tourist visa it is recommended that each participant address him or herself to the nearest French consulate in their country, or to contact travel agents for the necessary information regarding travel requirements.

4. Registration of Participants in the Meeting

All participants are invited to register at the counter in front of Meeting Room XII (UNESCO Fontenoy) on 19 July 2006 from 8.30 a.m. Each participant will receive a badge and relevant documents. Participants are requested to wear their badges at all times throughout the duration of the Meeting in order to facilitate the identification of participants.

5. Working Rooms

The meeting will be held from 19 to 21 July 2006 in the UNESCO Headquarters, Room XII Fontenoy building, (basement) from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

6. Working Documents

Participants will receive a complete set of meeting documents provided in the official six UNESCO languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish) prior to the meeting. A limited number of additional copies will be available at the meeting. All information

documents prepared during the meeting will be provided in the six official working languages of UNESCO as well.

Participants are reminded that the Secretariat will not be able to type, translate or reproduce any documents other than those directly relating to the work of the meeting (i.e. draft recommendations).

7. Practical Information

Participants can have lunch at the UNESCO Restaurant (Fontenoy, 7th floor) or at the Cafeteria. The Cafeteria in the other UNESCO building (1, rue Miollis, lower ground floor), is also open to participants.
