Proposed modification:

- (iii) the management, sharing and dissemination (“knowledge management”) of the most up-to-date understanding in the field of preparing and implementing the curriculum by encouraging the creation of a Euro-Mediterranean and South-South educational innovations network to exchange best educational practices in this field;

Explanatory note:**The major objectives of the network are to:**

1. Contribute to exchange educational experiences and best practices concepts and practices;
2. Foster collaborative efforts for investigating, systematizing, consolidating and disseminating innovations;

3. Make possible a venue for communication and exchange among educators and other professionals;
4. Enriching and strengthening the complex process of implementing innovations; and
5. Facilitating linkages between innovative practices, research, teacher training and education policies.

The network activities will cover formal and non-formal education of children, young people and adults among stakeholders. The main fields of interest of the network are to promote and facilitate conditions, opportunities, settings and resources so as to foster processes of collective thinking and action in the area of formal and non-formal education within the holistic vision of UNESCO's Education for All (EFA) goals.

The network thematic areas are: school curriculum and textbook revision and change; professional development of educators' competencies on the use of ICT facilities in teaching (i.e. the use of data loggers in science education); e-content development; education policy development tools; and strengthening democracy and citizenship.

Outputs:

1. Theoretical and practical knowledge generated for the transformation of educational practices.
2. A website will be developed for disseminating relevant experiences for guiding the changes that teachers and other education professionals wish to carry out.
3. Training programmes in the field of educational policy, new technologies, and instructional methods and curriculum carried out.
4. Meetings (or summer camps) organized for the exchange of best practices. Among the training processes of special note is a workshop on research and systematization of educational innovations.
