Resolution 03000:

4. Modification of biennial sectoral priority 1: Promoting principles, practices and ethical norms relevant for scientific and technological development to become an overarching interdisciplinary (and intersectoral) priority of Major Programmes II and III;
5. Subparagraph (v) of biennial sectoral priority 2 concerning physical education is proposed to be integrated in Major Programme I/Education;
6. Addition to draft resolution 02000 (b): to allocate for this purpose “and for the establishment of a Science Advisory Committee” in the amount of ...;
7. Addition to draft resolution 03000 (b): to allocate for this purpose “and for the establishment of a Science Advisory Committee” in the amount of ...

Explanatory note:

The proposed changes support the recommendations of the Review Committee putting, among others, main focus on the strengthening of policy advice towards capacity-building needs. The establishment of an overarching Science Advisory Committee would significantly contribute to UNESCO'S laboratory of ideas and watch functions and would assist in anticipation of trends and emerging challenges in the fields of sciences (to be supported by the internal task force). Main line of action 5 of MP III should focus on the follow-up and monitoring of the International Convention against Doping in Sport and leave aside “traditional games and sport”, and is proposed to be integrated in Major Programme I with the expected result “national capacities to integrate physical education and sports policies in national education systems improved”.
