**DRAFT RESOLUTIONS PROPOSING AMENDMENTS
TO THE DRAFT PROGRAMME AND BUDGET FOR 2010-2011 (35 C/5)**

OUTLINE

This document presents an overview and a summary by Commission of the admissible amendments proposed by Member States to the draft resolutions contained in Volume 1 of the Draft Programme and Budget for 2010-2011 (35 C/5 Rev.). The various amendments will be considered by the commissions concerned, and the observations by the Director-General with regard to each of these admissible amendments are contained in the separate documents 35 C/8 PRX, 35 C/8 ADM, 35 C/8 ED, 35 C/8 SC, 35 C/8 SHS, 35 C/8 CLT, 35 C/8 CI and 35 C/8 Joint (Joint Meeting of Commissions).

INTRODUCTION

1. By the deadline of 21 August 2009, 82 draft resolutions, sponsored or co-sponsored by 55 Member States, had been received by the Secretariat proposing to amend specific portions of the Draft Programme and Budget for 2010-2011 (35 C/5 Rev.).¹ Each draft resolution was subject to an in-depth examination as to its technical admissibility by a Secretariat Screening Group established for this purpose. Of the 82 draft resolutions, 78 were deemed admissible and have been translated into the six working languages, reproduced in the series 35 C/DR and distributed. With regard to the remaining 4 draft resolutions, three were withdrawn by their sponsors and one was deemed inadmissible. The sponsor was provided with the reasons therefore and informed of the procedure to be followed should they wish to appeal to the General Conference.

2. In line with the procedure set forth in Rules 80 and 81 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference and the "Explanatory Note" adopted by the Legal Committee and in accordance with 176 EX/Decision 35 of the Executive Board, a draft resolution may only be considered inadmissible in one of the following cases:

- (a) the proposed amendment does not relate to a draft resolution proposed by the Director-General, as contained in Volume 1 of 35 C/5 Rev. second version;
- (b) the budgetary implication of the draft amendment is equal to or lower than US \$40,000;
- (c) the draft amendment does not have international, regional or subregional scope;
- (d) the activity proposed in the draft amendment meets all the conditions required in order to be financed under the Participation Programme (see 33 C/Resolution 60).

3. Of the 78 admissible draft resolutions, 12 have been estimated by their authors as having financial implications, to be funded either from the regular budget or extrabudgetary resources. The Director-General comments on the substantive aspects of the proposed amendments as well as, as the case may be, their estimated budgetary implications, which are contained in the separate documents 35 C/8 PRX, 35 C/8 ED, 35 C/8 SC, 35 C/8 SHS, 35 C/8 CLT, 35 C/8 CI, 35 C/8 ADM and 35 C/8 Joint (Joint Meeting of Commissions) to be examined by the respective commissions.

4. All 78 admissible draft resolutions are listed by commission in the annex to this document. This list provides information on all Member States wishing to co-sponsor certain draft resolutions, to the extent that they had informed the Secretariat prior to the finalization of the present document.

¹ One additional draft resolution was received after the expiration of the deadline.
