PROGRAMME CULTURE COMMISSION

DRAFT TIMETABLE OF WORK

Room II, 15, 16, 17, 19 and 21 October

1. The Chairperson submits herewith for the approval of the Commission the draft timetable of work (Annex), which has been drawn up taking into account the recommendations formulated by the Executive Board and adopted by the General Conference concerning the organization of the work of the 35th session (35 C/2 Rev.).
2. The Chairperson proposes to organize the Commission's work into six debates. The first will focus on agenda item 4.2, namely the consideration of the Draft Programme and Budget for 2010-2011 (35 C/5, Part II.A: Major Programme IV – Culture). Agenda items 8.3 and 8.2 will be considered during the second debate; items 5.11, 5.13, 5.18 and 5.20 will be considered during the third debate; the fourth debate will focus on items 5.21 and 5.6, the fifth on item 8.1 and the sixth will concentrate on items 5.2 and 5.3.
3. At the end of each debate, the representative of the Director-General will answer the questions raised by the delegates, if required to do so.
4. The Chairperson wishes to draw the attention of the delegations to the procedure described in document 35 C/2 Rev. (paras. 40-44) for processing draft resolutions proposing the adoption of amendments to the Draft Programme and Budget. The Director-General's observations on the draft resolutions deemed admissible are contained in document 35 C/8/CLT. The Chairperson particularly draws attention to the fact that the aim of the debates will be wherever possible to find a satisfactory outcome, within the Commission, for every proposal. He invites the delegations which are the originators of draft resolutions having budgetary implications to specify, in taking the floor, the source of funding for the implementation of the proposed activities, by identifying activities to be dropped or scaled down or by recourse to other sources of financing (Participation Programme or extrabudgetary funds).
5. The Culture Commission will adopt its report on Wednesday 21 October in the afternoon.

6. The Chairperson takes this opportunity to point out that, if the examination of any item takes less time than foreseen, he will instantly start the debate on the following question.

7. In order to facilitate the organization of the work, the delegates may request their inclusion on the list of speakers in Room II at the beginning of each of the six debates. The list of speakers for each debate will be closed after the intervention of the third delegate. Observers who wish to speak on an item should preferably inform the secretariat beforehand, and will be called at the appropriate time.
